

# Micro-Needling with PRP



Microneedling with PRP has many Benefits, including:

- Evens skin tone
- Improves the appearance of fine lines and wrinkles
- Gives skin a fresh glow
- Gives the skin a firmer and smoother texture
- Reduces broken capillaries, spider veins & acne scars
- Reduces appearance of large pores and sun spots

Beautiful, fresh, glowing skin is an asset, giving the face and body a youthful appearance. A professional skincare regime helps to maintain, preserve and protect the skin from sun damage, fine lines, and wrinkles- but as time passes, collagen production slows, and topical treatments are not enough. Then it is time to take a bigger step and rejuvenate your skin. Microneedling with PRP may be the right treatment option. This is one of the latest, most effective innovations in aesthetics and can give you dramatic results.



## What is Microneedling with PRP?

Microneedling is a treatment that involves the use of tiny needles that produce micro-injuries to the skin. These micro-injuries stimulate the body's natural collagen production – that substance that provides flexibility and strength to skin and body tissue. To speed the healing process, microneedling is further enhanced by injecting or brushing PRP (Platelet Rich Plasma) into the treated tissue. The PRP is obtained from drawing a small amount of your own blood, from which the plasma is separated to concentrate healing properties. Microneedling with PRP can be used in several different areas of the body, including the face, neck, arms, de'collete', arms, abdomen, back, hands and legs.

## How PRP Therapy Works!

PRP is created from a person's own blood, and is a concentrated blend of plasma cells and specific growth factors. When injected into tissue, it bathes the cells to naturally stimulate the healing process. This advanced technique is often used by professional athletes who need to recover as quickly as possible, to help reduce the recovery time. As a regenerative technique that accelerates the body's natural healing processes, in conjunction with microneedling, the treated area of skin can restore and rejuvenate for a firmer, more youthful texture and flexibility.

# What to expect with Microneedling with PRP



## Phase 1

Before your treatment begins, a numbing gel is applied to the skin area so the process is comfortable. The treatment begins with venipuncture (a blood draw) to obtain the patient's blood. This is relatively painless – aside from the first needle pinch. Then the blood is run through a centrifuge to isolate the platelets.



## Phase 2

The appropriate depth for the microneedling will then be selected, based on your skin type and condition. Then the provider uses a micro-needling device to create multiple micro-punctures in the skin area. Our clients report that the treatment is not uncomfortable, with a sensation like a light sandpaper moving across your skin. Our microneedling treatments require about one hour to complete, depending upon the size of the body area to be rejuvenated.



## Phase 3

Once the microneedling is complete, the provider paints the PRP with growth factors onto the micro-punctures so that the growth factors soak into the tissue for further stimulation of tightening and skin rejuvenation. After your treatment, you will notice immediate results, which will continue to improve over the next few days and weeks. As your body's natural collagen production is now stimulated, you should see the texture and quality of your skin continue to improve for up to six months. Recovery time is about one to three days depending on how aggressive the treatment.
